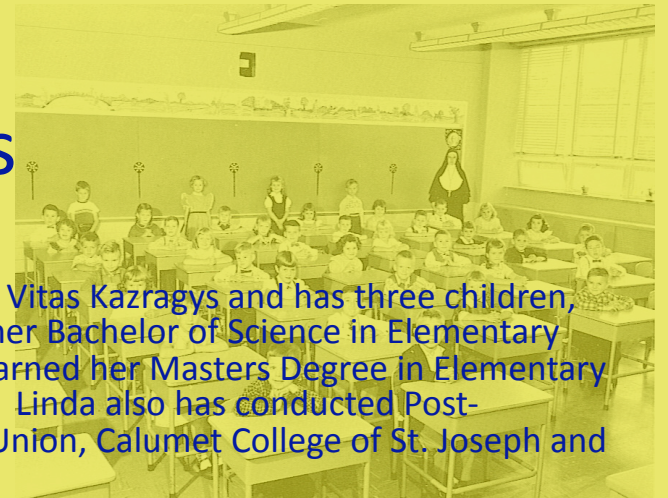




Mrs. Linda Kazragys
